

# RULES and REGULATIONS - Fishing, Caravan & Camping

## Fishing

To ensure visitors' safety and security and to maintain the environmental integrity of the area, the following rules and regulations are in effect at Llŷn Lakes. All anglers and visitors must read and accept the terms and conditions before fishing or visiting the farm.

1	Anglers & visitors must adhere to the Welsh Countryside Code, which can be accessed at <a href="http://www.countrysidecode.wales.org.uk/">www.countrysidecode.wales.org.uk/</a>
2	All vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area. No vehicles allowed near the lakes. Parking is entirely at owners' own risk.
3	All vehicle drivers must observe 5 mph speed limit within the farm boundaries.
4	No angler or visitor is allowed to walk in the fields without owners' permission. If permission to enter is given, walking will be at visitors' own risk.
5	Littering is prohibited. Anglers & Visitors must use the waste bins provided in the car park or take litter home.
6	No swimming in the lakes.
7	Environment Agency rod licence is required to fish at Llŷn Lakes (minimum 2 licenses for 3 rods). Anglers must present their licence for inspection prior to any fishing. 8	No fishing without a purchased ticket. One ticket is required per angler. Tickets are non-transferable.
9	Entry to bank for day ticket 07.30hrs, start fishing 08.00hrs.
10	No access to the lakes between the hours of 7.30pm – 7.30am, unless during management-approved night-fishing.
11	Night fishing (7pm – 7am) is by arrangement only and is limited to anglers who have previously participated in day fishing trips. Arrangement is at the sole discretion of management, whose decision is final.
12	Removal of fish from the lakes is prohibited.
13	All fish must be handled carefully and promptly returned to the water. Sacking is prohibited. All fish must be moved in sling or net - NEVER by hand - to avoid accidents.
14	BARBLESS hooks only.
15	No keep nets.
16	Minimum line of 8lbs, NO fixed leads (semi-fixed is allowed).
17	Maximum of 3 rods per angler allowed on bank (marker float allowed as extra).
18	Nut baits and pure seed beds (e.g. hemp/ birdseed/ pigeon seed conditioner) are prohibited.
19	Rubber/plastic/artificial bait (i.e. bait with no nutritional value) is prohibited.
20	Unhooking mats and antiseptic (e.g. klinik or bonjela) must be used at all times.
21	Dip tank instructions must be observed (for slings, nets and mats, if last used elsewhere previously).
22	Reasonable net size for main lake 36" minimum.
23	No anglers under 16 years allowed unless accompanied by an adult.
24	No dogs allowed (day kennelling facilities are available for anglers and visitors at a fee).
25	The management reserves the right to cancel reservations or refuse admission.
26	Payment is taken on acknowledgement of water rules/conditions. Failure to comply with terms will result in a ban- no refund will be given.
27	All persons entering the site do so entirely at their own risk.

# RULES and REGULATIONS - Caravan & Camping

To ensure visitors' safety and security and to maintain the environmental integrity of the area, the following rules and regulations are in effect when camping or caravanning. All visitors must read and accept the terms and conditions before caravanning and camping.

1	The pitch fee per night is an inclusive charge for the parking of caravan, motor caravan or tent (i.e. touring unit) and one car.
2	Park admission is from 12 noon on the day of arrival and pitches to be vacated by 11am on day of departure.
3	All prices quoted include VAT.
4	All rubbish should be put inside the wheelie bins (please recycle wherever possible).
5	No camp fires.
6	Disposable barbecues must be placed on bricks (can be provided) not on grass. Due consideration must be shown to all other visitors.
7	Excessive noise will not be tolerated.
8	Dogs are to be kept on a lead at all times, and in the interest of hygiene and safety all excrement must be removed immediately.
9	The site management reserves the right to evict without notice any caravan, tent, or occupants if there is cause, such as noise, nuisance, litter etc without refund of fees or deposit paid.
10	All fees must be paid prior to setting up of any caravan or tent.
11	During school holidays and bank holidays, tourers can only book for full weeks (Saturday to Saturday).
12	No refund given for bad weather, early departure etc.
13	25% deposit payable with booking. Balance payable in full on arrival.
14	High season = Schools and Bank Holidays.
15	Low season = All other dates between 1 April to 31 October.
