We do not rent or distribute any personal information to third party advertising companies, or any other companies, businesses or individuals.

We also use analytics cookies in order to monitor how our visitors use our website, with a view to making improvements and making the site more useful.

Information regarding Cookies.

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on every subsequent visit. Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognise a user's device.

Cookies do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improve your experience.

The cookies used on our website have been categorised based on the categories found in the ICC UK Cookie guide. A list of all the cookies used on this website by category is set out below.

How to find COOKIES on your computer:

Instructions

- 1. Click "Start" and "Run."
- 2. Type "inetcpl.cpl" without the quotation marks, & click OK to open the Internet settings.
- 3. Click the General Tab, and under "Browser history" click "Settings".
- 4. Click the Temporary Internet Files Tab, and click the "View files" button to show cookies and temporary Internet files.

The specific folder location is shown in the address bar.

If you SORT the documents via TYPE, all the cookies will be sorted as a Text Document.

The default setting on most browsers for cookies are ENABLED automatically. You can delete or control cookies via your browser.

The types of cookies on our website are classified developed by the International Chamber of Commerce UK.

Category 1: strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website. Without these cookies services you have asked for, like shopping baskets or e-billing, cannot be provided.

Category 2: performance cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works.

Category 3: functionality cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices and selections you make (such as your user name, language or the region you are in, local weather, traffic news etc...) and provide an enhanced, more personal features to you. When you browse though our website we take it that you agree to allow us to use this type of cookie on your computer. The information these cookies collect may be anonymised and they cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

Category 4: targeting or advertising cookies

These cookies are used to deliver adverts more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement as well as help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They are usually placed by advertising networks with the website operator's permission. They remember that you have visited a website and this information is shared with other organisations such as advertisers. Quite often targeting or advertising cookies will be linked to site functionality provided by the other organisation.

Google Analytics

Google Analytics is a free service offered by Google that generates detailed statistics about the visitors to a website. We use Google Analytics on our website to gather information about how you use the website, as well as your IP address. This information is generated by the cookie, and the information is then sent back to Google. The data about your website is then compiled and analysed via statistical reports, which Google stores.

To provide website visitors more choice on how their data is collected by Google Analytics, we have developed the Google Analytics Opt Out Browser Add-on. The add-on instructs the Google Analytics JavaScript not to send any information about the website visit to Google Analytics.
